## **CLASSIFICATION – REGULAR CLASSES**

The following CKC classes divided by sex will be offered:

JUNIOR PUPPY	6 months but under 9 months
SENIOR PUPPY	9 months but under 12 months
12 – 18 MONTHS	12 months but under 18 months
CANADIAN BRED	For dogs born in Canada, champions in any country are excluded
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	For dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.
OPEN	For all dogs.
SPECIALS ONLY*	For dogs that have a recorded CKC registration or ERN and have attained the required points for Championship status.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in Regular Class but may enter to compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
VETERAN	For any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.

## **NON-REGULAR CLASSES/AWARDS AVAILABLE AT SPECIALTIES**

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes.

Juvenile Sweepstakes:	Classes will be divided by sex & age as follows: See individual specialty for age breakdown/
Veteran Sweepstakes:	Classes will be divided by sex & age as follows: See individual specialty for age breakdown
Award of Merit	This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. A specialty club may offer one AOM for every 10 dogs competing at the BOB level, at the judge's discretion.
Best Candian Bred	This award maybe offered at the breed level. All Canadian bred dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another Canadian bred dog shall be eligible to compete for this award.
Sire & Get	Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.
Dam & Progeny	Brood bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.
Brace	Two dogs of the same breed (either sex or mixed). A brace must be handled by 1 person one lead.
Parades	Dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only to participate. Spayed, neutered or dogs in unorthodox trims may enter. See specialty for parade type

## **ALTERED DOG CLASSES**

These classes shall be for any sexually altered dogs over 6 months of age. These dogs will be judged after the regular classes Best of Breed Judging. Dogs are entered by sex only.

## CLASSIFICATION - OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASSES

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN NOVICE A AND NOVICE B AT THE SAME TRIAL

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN OPEN A AND OPEN B AT THE SAME TRIAL

- Pre Novice This class is for any dog that has not earned the title PCD (Pre Companion Dog) title in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged in group exercises. A dog may be entered in this class that has not earned the title of CD in Canada or US. The Pre Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to Novice Classes. The CKC will permit the use of PCD signifying the Pre Companion Dog to be used in connection with and after the name of the dog. In order to receive this title dogs must receive passing scores in three different trials under two different judges.
- Novice A This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of CD in ANY COUNTRY. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by his/her immediate family and must show the dog in all exercises. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class but must compete in the Novice B class.
- Novice B This class is open to all dogs that have not earned the title of CD and may be shown by the owner or any other person.
- Novice C This class is open to all dogs that have gained a CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced title and exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice classes, except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned in Novice C are not eligible for High In Trial. This is an elective class and offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience. Dogs may be entered in Novice C class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.
- Open A This class is open to all dogs that have earned the title of CD IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of CDX in any country. The exhibitor must be an owner or a member of his/her immediate family and must show the dog in all exercises. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but must compete in the Open B class, a CKC, ERN or PEN registration number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.
- Open B This class is open to all dogs that have earned the title CD in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog may also compete in the Utility Class. A CKC, ERN or PEN registration number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.
- Utility This class is open to all dogs that have earned the title CDX in CANADA. This dog may be shown by the owner or any other person. A CKC, ERN or PEN registration number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.
- Exhibition All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions, but may not compete in regular classes.
- Veterans This class shall be for dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veteran Class must also be entered in a regular class or exhibition only.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Dog Show Rule Books and Obedience Trial Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. In Canada call toll free 1-800-250-8040, in the United States call 1-416-675-5511.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules. Entries will be acknowledged after close of entries with receipt and judging schedule.

This Show will be open from 7:00 AM until completion of judging. Dogs must be on the show grounds one hour before the judging of their class.

Judging will not commence before 8:00 AM.

Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The starting time for each ring will be specified in the Judging Schedule.

PLEASE NOTE: You are responsible for cleaning up if your dog relieves itself.

The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons, or property.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: (Chapter 4, Section 4.1.3 of CKC Dog Show Rules) "A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season, after the entry of the bitch has been submitted, if a Veterinarian certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial) to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.

Entry fees shall NOT be refunded after the closing date. Nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the EKKOC it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs and children must be kept under control as a courtesy to fellow exhibitors and spectators.

## CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS & CANCELLATIONS

SECTION 15.1.1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a CONFORMATION show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

<b>DOGS COMPETING*</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3 to 5</b>	<b>6 to 9</b>	<b>10 to 12</b>	<b>13 or more</b>
<b>POINTS AWARDED</b>	<b>0</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>5</b>

\*includes the dog awarded WINNERS

In counting the number eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

See Sections 15.1.3 to 15.1.7 of the CKC Rules and Regulations for Championship Points.

SECTION 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group Level.

SECTION 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with no more than 5 championship points in a single show.

SECTION 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

SECTION 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best In Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

SECTION 15.1.12 In or for a dog to be recognized as a Champion, and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, a dog must:

- earned 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and
- be registered in the records of the CKC, have an ERN or MCN
- have earned a least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

**SECTION 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.**

### ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques 'Payable in Canadian Funds' or 'At Par'. They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.
